#### **BEWARE OF TIDES AND HERRING PEN**

### **Rules & Regulations:**

- 1. No smoking on pier or dock.
- 2. No fishing/crabbing/harvesting from pier or dock.
- 3. No open containers of alcohol on dock.
- 4. All persons under age 12 must wear life jackets at all times when on dock.
- 5. All boats must have Coast Guard approved life jackets readily available to each person on board and must be worn by persons under age 12 at all times.
- 6. Boaters shall comply with No Wake Zone.
- 7. It is unlawful for any person under the influence of drugs or alchohol to operate a boat.
- No person shall moor a boat in the Blue Zone, or for more than 3 hours in any other zone, without prior reservations from Narrows Marina Moorage Office or by Pre-Paying at Tackle Store. Reservations can be madeTuesday – Saturday 8:30am to 4pm (253) 564-3032.
- 9. In consideration of Narrows Marina providing moorage for your boat, you hereby waive any and all claims for damages against Narrows Marina or its employees, that you, your family, or guest now have or might hereafter have, by reason of injury sustained or in connection with use of said moorage, including use of docks, piers, shore facilites, or damage to your boat and/or its content, by fire or the elements while moored at Narrows Marina.
- 10. All boats with a holding tank have the availability to use the pump-out station located at the Narrows Marina Fuel Dock (White Zone), \$5.00 for non-tenants, must pre-pay at Tackle Store.

- 11. Discharge of oily or dirty bilge water is illegal.
- 12. Disposal of used oil, antifreeze, paint solvents, varnishes or batteries into the garbage is illegal.
- 13. No person shall conduct work on their boat at Narrows Marina.
- 14. Temporary no cost BH19 and NBC moorage is always allowed between 11AM and 11PM in the Green Zone for stays of 3-Hrs or less. Stays between 11PM and 11AM or longer than 3-HRS require prior NM approval or risk citation/impound/lockup.
  - a. Same as Rule 14; except max boat width is 10'.
- 15. Sounds carry on water. Please be respectful of our neighbors and keep noise to a minimum. Between 9:00 pm and 8am, boaters must prevent noise from being heard outside of their vessel.
- 16. Do not leave children under age 16 unattended on pier, dock, or boat.
- 17. Temporary Moorage is available up to 15-days maximum.
- 18. The Orange Zone is for Commercial Herring. 15-minute maximum stay **NO MOORAGE**. Beware, nets are an entanglement hazard.

## **Penalties:**

Improperly moored vessels may be impounded (moved, cited, locked-up, towed, or removed from the water). An impound fee of \$120 will be charged along with a storage fee of \$2/ft/day. Any impounds are at the vessle owners risk and expense, Narrows Marina is not responsible for damages. Vessels will only be released, Mon thru Sat between 8:30 AM and 4PM (253) 564-3032. We reserve the right to refer unpaid accounts to collections.

- \$120 lock up fee
- \$2/ft/day impound fee
- Citations: \$50 for improperly moored vessels, additional charges apply if moored without approval.

# <u>Temp Moorage Rates (Reservations Required or Pre-Payment at Tackle Store):</u>

- \$1.00 per ft/per day (\$25 minimum)
- \$4.50 per day Shore Power (Shore power only available for vessels smaller than 30')
